School Reopening Grants Program Round 2 Winners

Kicking the Kindergarten Experience Up a Pandemic Notch, a multi-tiered approach - Burton Elementary School - \$4,500

This project will provide academic and emotional-support for kindergarten students. The team will purchase items such as headphones, book kits, lap desks, and playground equipment.

Electricity for Outdoor Teaching Greenhouse - Carrington Middle School - \$9,500

Funds for this project will support the completion of Carrington's greenhouse and outdoor learning space. The learning space will be used by the CTE and Science Departments and is estimated to impact 400 students this year. DPS Foundation previously supported the greenhouse with a grant in 2019.

iConnect through Outdoor Learning and Engagement - CC Spaulding Elementary School - \$3,300

Outdoor learning environment--Funds will be used to purchase picnic tables and benches.

A Wellness and Mindful Return to CMA - City of Medicine Academy - \$6,520

Funds will be used for outdoor gaming and learning activities, as well as wellness and mindfulness resources.

Eagles Go Hybrid - EK Powe Elementary School - \$4,300

This project will use funds to purchase items related to technology needs, such as headphones and microphone sets.

Safety First in First Grade - Glenn Elementary School - \$7,200

Outdoor learning environment--Glenn will use funds for picnic tables, benches, stools, and PPE.

Creative, Fun & Engaging...Even From a Hospital Bed! - Hospital School - \$2,500

This project will provide students with foldable/portable dry erase boards as well as STEM materials such as pens, workbooks, and brain teazers.

Air Purifiers for Each Classroom/Clean Air Needs at LRS - Little River K-8 School - \$5,000

Little River will be using these funds to purchase air purifiers for each classroom.

Document Cameras for Improved Virtual Teaching and Learning - Neal Middle School - \$5,400

These funds will be used to purchase document cameras to better support teachers with both in-person and online learning. The cameras provide an additional video source and enable seamless switching between the webcam and camera for more interactive and engaging teaching.

The PRIDE of Parkwood - Parkwood Elementary School - \$6,300

Parkwood will be using these funds to provide picnic tables, benches, sun shades, and plants to improve their outdoor learning environment.

Outdoor Learning Spaces Project - Riverside High School - \$7,080

These funds will be used to purchase air purifiers for classrooms where students will be learning in-person.
