Teacher Satisfaction Survey

In 2025, 661 DPS teachers from 45 school sites responded to C2C's teacher satisfaction survey. Grades ranged from early childhood through high school, though most respondents teach elementary school. Only 17% were new teachers.

Survey Results

- DPS teachers reported that C2C help them annually save up to \$419 per person. 24% of teachers shared they spend over \$300 on school supplies every year.
- The majority of the group stated C2C was very important in helping them prepare and their students learn. Teachers also said that C2C made them feel supported and appreciated.
- 630 of the 661 teachers who responded to the survey had previously shopped at C2C. Of the 117 new teachers who were surveyed, 72% said these free supplies were beneficial. 60% reported that C2C reduced their stress either very much or quite a bit.
- Teachers who had previously used C2C generally found the online teacher shop accessible and satisfactory. They also thought the program team did a good job at notifying teachers about the shopping schedule. Some feedback was provided, which C2C reviews to improve the user experience.
- Overall, DPS teachers who had shopped at C2C were very satisfied with their experience. 99% of new teachers recommended that the new teacher orientation be held every year. C2C accepted and asked for feedback to help improve the experience for teachers.
